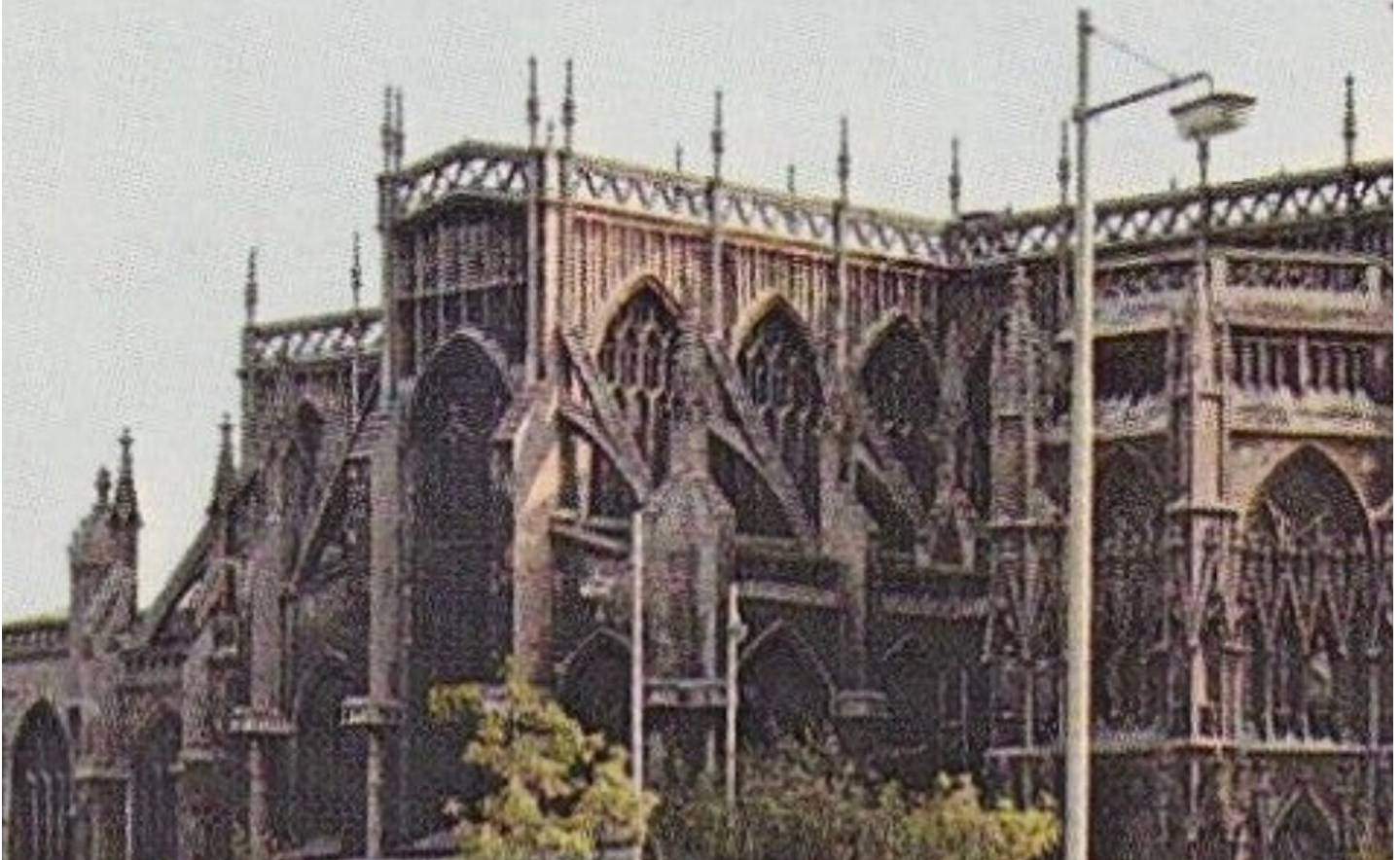
## a-level subjects:
