To ensure you are ready to fully access the A Level Syllabus you should attempt these tasks:

## **Section A - Essential**

Students are to research two of these areas and be prepared to give a short presentation to a small group in lessons in September.

- 1 The French Revolution how it started, key events and what happened afterwards (*listen to BBC Sounds The Real Dictators- Napoleon* for an excellent podcast and overview)
- 2 The Paris Riots of 1968 how it started, key events and what happened afterwards
- 3 Modern beliefs about Paris and Parisians stereotypes, reality, connotations of the city

#### Section B - Desirable

Research **The Troubles** in Northern Ireland from 1960s to 1990s. Create a page of hand-written notes. This will be useful for studying Seamus Heaney after Christmas.

### Section C - Desirable

More of a challenge: Read **The Tollund Man** by Seamus Heaney. Find out who the Danish Bog People were and why Heaney wrote about them.
