



Data Drop	What assessment(s) informs this data drop?	How is this assessment marked, moderated and feedback to students?
1	Assessments informing the data drop-baseline and endpoint assessments in students' workbooks show the progress students make during the lesson. At the end of each unit, students are set a multiple-choice quiz as homework to assess their knowledge and understanding of key concepts.	Students see their scores and any mistakes made in their answers. VIP teachers can see their students' marks and the VIP co-ordinator can use this data to add / amend to the schemes of work to address common errors and gaps in students' knowledge.
